## **1 Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016*
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia (YA).
- 1.3 The 12ft skiff rules as defined in the *Interdominion 12ft Sailing Championship Rules*, as accepted on 07/01/2012
- 1.4 Any changes to the Racing Rules will be outlined in the Regatta Sailing Instructions

## **2 Advertising**

The organising authority will require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising

## **3 Eligibility and Entry**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 12 foot skiff class(es).
- 3.2 To be eligible to compete in these championships each competitor shall be a financial member of either:  
Queensland 12ft Skiff Association  
NSW 12ft Skiff Association  
NZ 12ft Skiff Association  
Or  
Selected team member of Australia or New Zealand 12ft Skiffs
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the official Entry Form that shall be lodged with the Qld Association Secretary no later than 1700 hrs on the 7<sup>th</sup> December 2012, accompanied by the required fee by cheque. (Refer Entry Fee)

## **4 Entry Fee**

- 4.1 Entries prior to 7<sup>th</sup> December 2012      \$AUD 250 (incl GST) per boat
- 4.2 Entries after 7<sup>th</sup> December 2012      \$AUD 300 (incl GST) per boat

- 4.3 Entries cancelled in the week preceding the event will not be refunded. If cancellation occurs prior to this date, 75% of the fee will be refunded upon receipt of a written request.
- 4.4 Additional Presentation Tickets = \$30  
Additional tickets available for purchase with entry form and payment.

## 5 Race Schedule

A total of 10 races (excluding the Invitation Race) are scheduled. There are two lay days scheduled for 7<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> January 2012 on which no racing will be conducted. The Race Committee reserves the right to schedule races 10<sup>th</sup> January 2012 in the event of re-sails being required due to weather conditions.

## **7 Measurement**

All boats shall comply with the 12ft skiff class rules as agreed in Addendum A of the *Interdominion 12ft Sailing Championship Rules*. Random measurement checks and inspections may be carried out at any time for compliance to measurement rules. A boat notified of inspection shall follow the instructions of the Race Committee.

## **8 Sailing Instructions**

Sailing instructions will be available from Friday 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2013 from the organising body.

## **9 Venue**

Attachment A shows the approximate area (Sailing Area A for bay courses, Sailing Area B for round the cans) where courses will be set, together with the relative location of the Darling Point Sailing Squadron and the boat harbour.

## **10 Courses**

The courses to be sailed will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

## **11 Penalty System**

RRS 44.1 is amended so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe is required.

## **12 Scoring**

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply for the individual results. Team results will be a high point system outlined in Section 14 of the *Interdominion 12ft Sailing Championship Rules*.

## **13 Safety**

All competitors shall wear personal floatation devices while on the water, which are in good condition and are in accordance with the specification issues or approved by a national authority of standard organisation.

## **14 Radio Communications**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions whilst racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. Restrictions also apply to mobile telephones.

## **15 Prizes**

Prizes to be awarded are as follows:

- 15.2 Don Brooke Trophy for Australia vs. New Zealand
- 15.3 Nimble Trophy for best placed rookie
- 15.4 Advanx Veterans Trophy
- 15.5 Miners Trophy

## **16 Insurance**

All boats shall have current Third Party Insurance with a racing cover considered by the insurer as adequate for the risks involved. Minimum AUD\$5million or equivalent thereof for any incident.

## **17 Race Committee & Rescue Facilities**

Silvia Talbot has come aboard as our PRO along with her husband Peter. Silvia is a certified National Race Officer with experience including the 2010 12ft Skiff Australian Championships and the 2012 Laser Radial Worlds. A start launch and a minimum of 2 crewed rescue boats will be provided for the regatta.
