## **NOTICE OF RACE**

## **1. Date**

1.1. The regatta will be conducted from Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2014 to Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2014.

## **2. Organizing Authority: Worser Bay Boating Club (WBBC)**

## **3. Venue: Wellington Harbour, New Zealand**

## **4. Rules**

4.1. The regatta shall be governed by the current rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS)2013-2016, the prescriptions of the NZYF and by the Sailing Instructions.

4.2. The 12ft skiff rules as defined in the Interdominion 12ft sailing championship rules, as accepted on 12/01/2013.

4.3. Any changes to the Racing Rules will be outlined in the regatta sailing instructions.

## **5. Eligibility and Entry**

5.1. The regatta is open to all 12ft Skiffs. Eligible boats may enter the regatta by completing the official entry form available from the WBBC prior to racing commencing.

5.2. Rclass Skiffs are eligible to race, however are not eligible for any 12ft Skiff trophies

5.3. Entries will be accepted during registration times listed below.

5.4. A fee of NZ\$300 must accompany all 12ft Skiff and Rclass skiff entries.

## **6. Schedule of Races**

Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> January Registration and Invitation Race.

Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> January Heats 1 and 2

Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January Heat 3 and 4

Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> January Heat 5

Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January Reserve Day

Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> January Heats 6 and 7

Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January Heats 8 and 9

Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> January Heat 10 and Presentation Dinner

6.1. The Race Committee reserves the right to reschedule races and schedule races on the 8<sup>th</sup> January 2014 in the event of re-sails being required due to weather conditions.

6.2. No racing will start after 2.30pm on Saturday 11th January.

## **7. Measurement**

7.1. All boats shall comply with the 12ft skiff class rules as agreed in Addendum A of the Interdominion 12ft sailing Championship Rules. Random measurement checks may be carried out at any time during the regatta at the discretion of the race committee.

## **8. Sailing instructions**

8.1. The sailing instructions will be available at Worser Bay Boating Club from Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2014, and will be handed out with acceptance of entry.

## **9. Racing Area**

9.1. The racing area will be on Wellington Harbour. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions and may include both laid windward leeward courses and harbour courses.



## 10. Scoring

- 10.1. The low points scoring system of appendix A apply. Five races are required to constitute a series. When fewer than six races have been completed, a skiff's score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.2. Where six or more races have been completed, a skiff's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.3. Where eight or more races have been completed, a skiff's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## 12. Penalty System

- 12.1. Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two-penalty turns is replaced with one-turn penalty.

## 13. Disclaimer

- 13.1. It is the competitor's decision to enter the event or start and continue in any race.
- 13.2. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. See rule 4, decision to race.
- 13.3.
